Council Meeting 24 th July	Mid Suffolk's monthly council meeting took place this month on the 24 th July. Within the meeting, the council discussed the new sports and community pavilion at Chiltern Fields (SHELF), the performance report of CIFCO, an investment company owned by Mid Suffolk, underwriting a funding gap for the Stowmarket Food Museum, and the appointment of Cllr Terence Carter as council disability champion.
Adoption of Three Unitary Authorities	At the council Meeting on 24-08-2025 Cllr Richard Winch submitted a motion to full council regarding MSDC's desire to move forward with unitary authorities, as part of local government re-organisation across Suffolk. The 5 district councils across Suffolk, including Mid Suffolk, have long been supporters of having multiple unitary authorities across Suffolk, in opposition to the county council's support of a single unitary covering all of Suffolk.

It crosses the A140 at The White Horse, turns right at the 4 Horseshoes, then left along Thornham Road to Gislingham.
